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Committee Purpose:

The Career Development Quarterly (CDQ) is the official journal of NCDA. The Editor is responsible for editing and preparing four issues of the *CDQ* per year, preparing an annual report for the NCDA Board, and coordinating business functions of the *CDQ* with ACA officials including plans for expansion of subscriptions. The *CDQ* Editorial Board Members are recommended by the Editor and approved by the NCDA Board. The Editorial Board is responsible for editorial policy and content of the *CDQ*.

Committee Activities to Date:

- 1. Editorial Board meeting held June 30, 2016 at NCDA annual conference in Chicago.
- 2. Impact Factor = .87; 5-Year Impact Factor = 1.18; Accept ratio (prior 12 mos.) = 22/81 (27%)
- 3. March 2017 issue submitted to production August 22, 2016.
- 4. June 2017 issue submitted to production November 18, 2016.

- 5. Decreased time lag from manuscript acceptance to print publication from approxiamately 16 months to approximately 9 months at the present time.
- 6. Responded to numerous inquiries about CDQ policy, NCDA resources, manuscripts, publication guidelines, journal ratings, acceptance rates, and the like.
- 7. Fourteen editorial members re-appointed for two-year terms of service.
- 8. Five editorial board members ended terms of service:

Rivera, Queens College, City University of New York (3 two-year terms) Hsiu-Lan Shelley Tien, National Taiwan Normal University (2 two-year terms) Ellen Hawley McWhirter, University of Oregon (2 two-year terms) Richard A. Young, University of British Columbia (3 two-year terms)

- 9. Reviewers now receive 30% discount on Wiley books with every review. Discount can be used in any country, by any reviewer. Discount excludes major reference works.
- 10. Hartung completes initial three-year term as editor December 31, 2016.

- 1. Submit September 2017 issue by March 1, 2017.
- 2. Process all submitted and resubmitted manuscripts in a timely, efficient, and effective manner.
- 3. Provide all submitting authors with thorough, thoughtful, useful, and encouraging reviews.
- 4. Work with authors to publish articles of the highest quality.
